

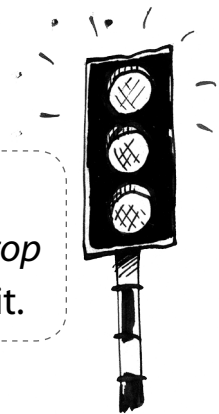


Red words
