#### How you can support your child's learning:

- Attendance every day matters
- Home learning maths and spellings every week
  - Set on Thursdays and due in the following Tuesday
  - Support by making sure your child has a quiet space to concentrate
  - Doesn't all need doing in one go find out what works for you and your child. 5 minutes every day on the way to the school, football or the shops is the best way to learn spellings
  - If your child is stuck, don't panic just let us know

#### How you can support your child's learning:

- Reading either listening to your child read, or encouraging to read independently, then talking about what they've read
- Continuing to learn times table facts (in the car or on the walk to and from school)
- Talk to your child about what they did and better still what they learnt - at school today
- Finding different ways to engage them in conversation –
  What made you laugh? What make you smile?
- PE kit in school on a Monday home on Friday for a wash.
- Swimming kit in school every Tuesday.
