
In September, we are moving up to Year 3...

5. We will have PE lessons with Mr Butler twice a week.


Mr Butler really likes playing golf and cricket, but he doesn't like spiders.

In maths, we will be learning about place value, working with numbers to 1000.




10. In Science, we will be learning about forces and magnets, light, rocks and healthy eating over the course of the year.
